Program Description

In Paterson Jeopardy, students embark on a guided tour highlighting the city's industrial and cultural legacy. Participants get hands-on with authentic artifacts, bringing history to life through tactile learning. The experience wraps up with a lively Jeopardy-style game that tests their knowledge of Paterson's history in a fun and educational way.

Activities

- Artifact handling
- Jeopardy game

Location Requirement

This program can be held at The Paterson Museum or offsite. Offsite option is only available for Paterson locations. The offsite location must have tables, chairs, a projector, and computer with PowerPoint access.
